## Opening Worship Time

Children will sit at designated areas with their group/crew.

<b>Bible Verse</b>	Read Luke 10:27 to the group. Explain that this week they will learn to Love God and love others.	Everyone read verse Luke 10:27 together. <b>Pray and dismiss to rotations</b>	God, help us learn to <u>love You</u> .	God, help us learn that <u>Jesus is our Savior</u> .	God, help us make You <u>Lord of our life</u> .	God, help us <u>love You with our heart, soul, strength and mind</u> .	God, help us <u>love our neighbor</u> .

\*\*There are motions you can use as you teach the children the Bible Verse. These are included at the end of each Bible lesson (see Bible Story Teaching Guide). You may use the motions in your Bible Rotation and in your Worship time as children are learning the Bible verse.

## Closing Worship Time

- Play the day’s song as children come into the whole group time.
- Ask children what they learned or what was their favorite part of today’s VBS. You can also have a question ready to ask about Haiti or something from the Bible story as you review the day’s lessons.
- Remind children about the Love in Action Project.
- Review the memory verse and pray as you close.
