Day 3, Saving Soap: Bring a bar of soap. As your child brings the soap, you can remind them how we need soap to keep our bodies clean, but Jesus is the only way to clean us from our sin. As they use soap this week, have them remember to pray for the people in Haiti to know Jesus.

Day 4, Tooth-tastic Gifts: Bring toothpaste or a toothbrush. As your child brushes his/her teeth this week, remind them to pray for the ministry as it continues to tell others about Jesus. As a family, talk about how you can tell others about Jesus.

Day 5 House Warming: You can choose needed items for the home the choir children will stay in while they are in the United States. Pray for the choir as they travel to churches in America. Find out about our current needs by contacting Love Him Love Them.
